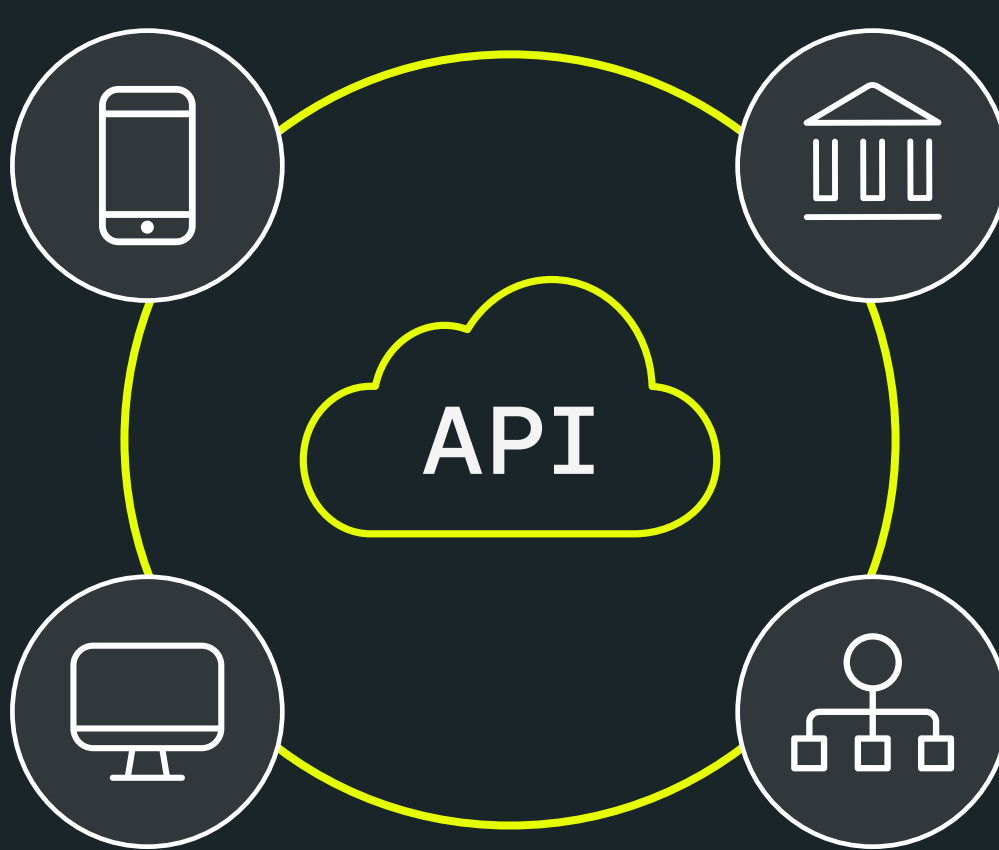


APIs: The New Standard for Connectivity

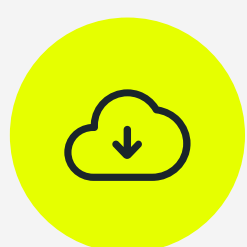
What is an API?

Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) allow two or more pieces of software to communicate across internal or external servers.

APIs connect different systems to share data automatically with higher frequency - this includes ERPs and other software packages.

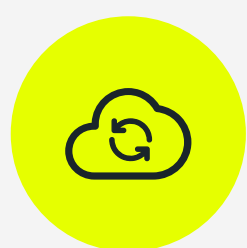
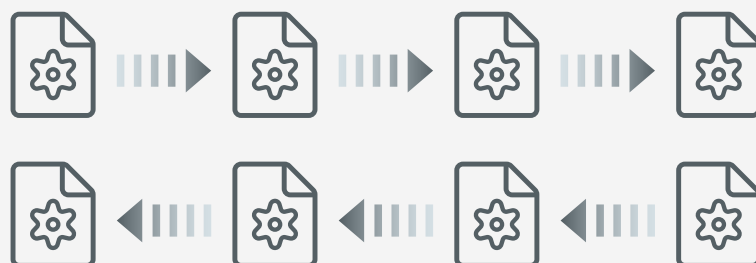
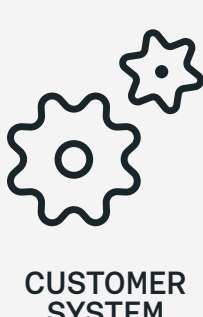


Traditional SFTP/FTP vs Open API



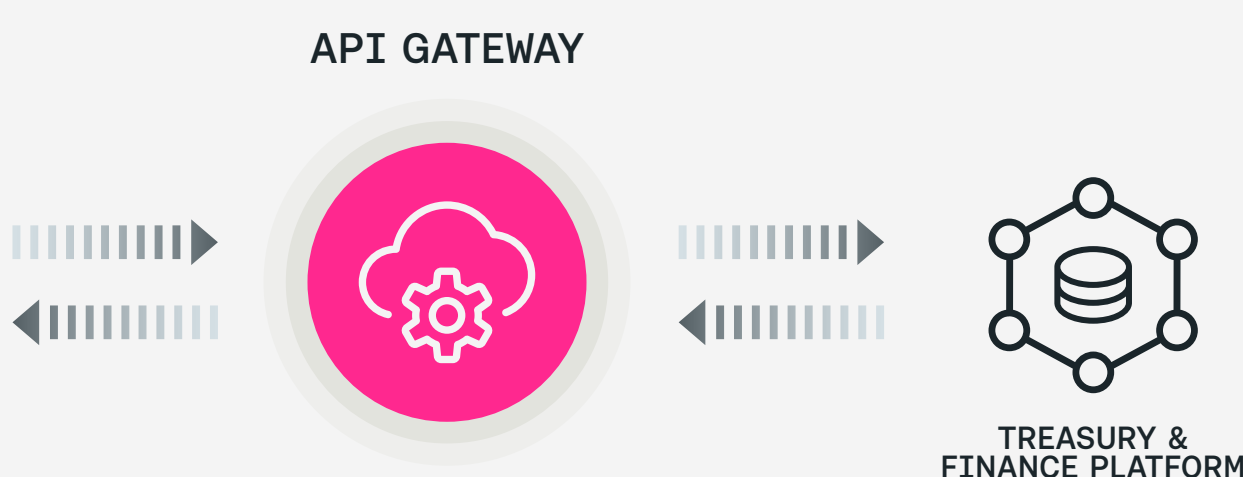
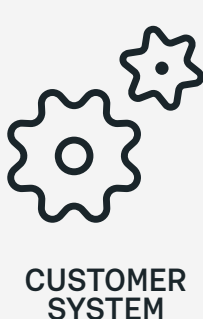
The Traditional SFTP/FTP Gateway

With SFTP/FTP, files are selected and downloaded every 5-10 minutes in a complex process.



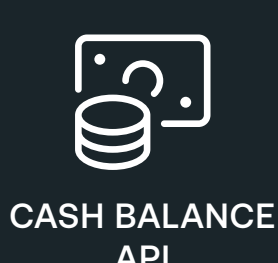
Open API Platform
